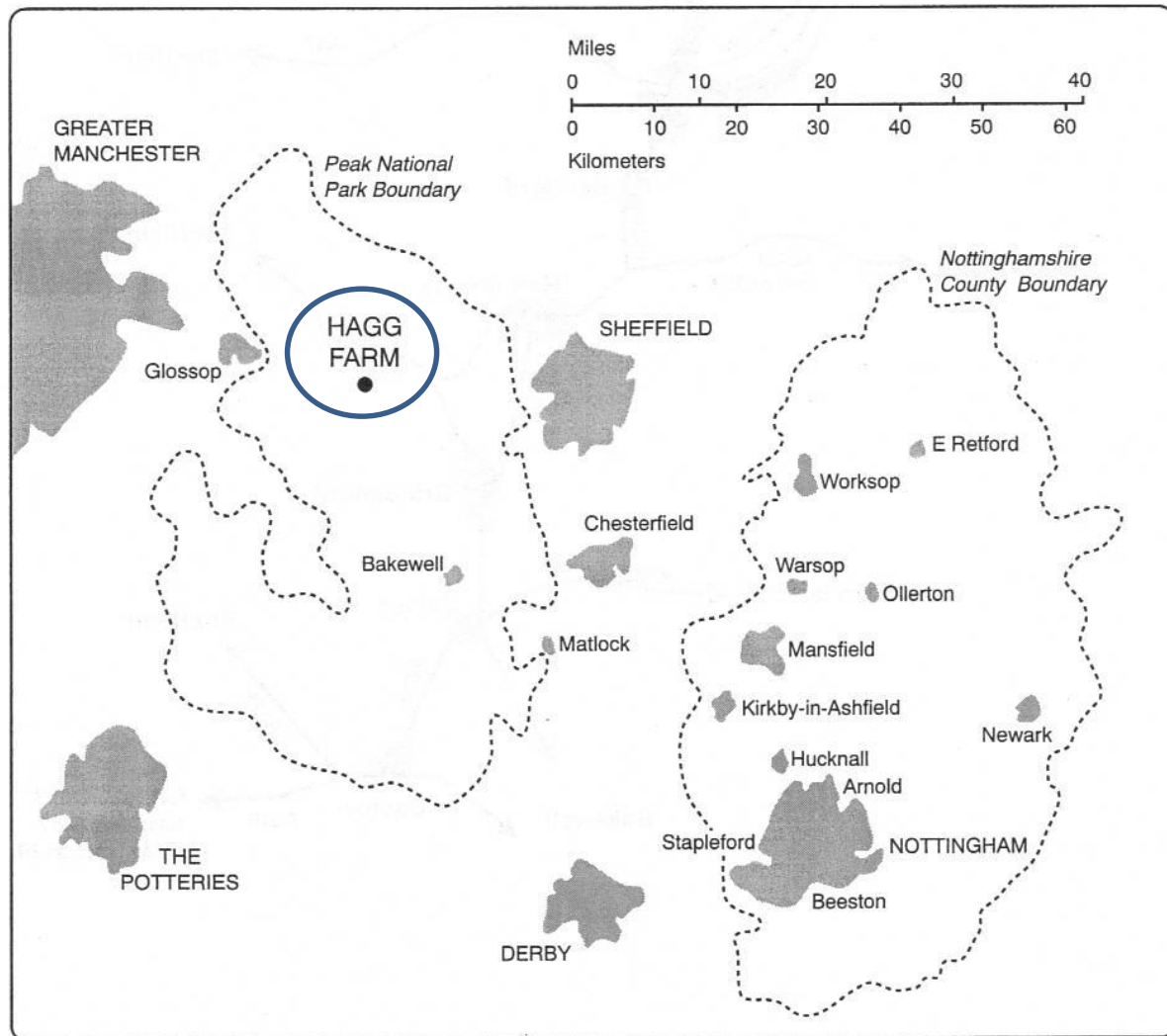

## Return to School

# Residential Trip to Hagg Farm

## Valuables and Money

- If students want to bring a small amount of pocket money (no more than £5), there is a gift shop available to buy souvenirs at the end of the trip.
- Mobile phones are not allowed (there is very little signal at Hagg Farm!).
- Students are encouraged to bring a disposable camera if they want to take photos.
- Staff will not take responsibility for any valuables on the trip (it is not recommended to bring expensive electrical devices – students won't have time to use them anyway!)





# Residential Trip to Hagg Farm

## Essential Parental Administration

- Final reminder – full payment of £150 is now due. The deadline is 3rd January 2020.
- We also require the OV4 (medical consent form) in order to take your child on the trip. Your child needs to hand this to their tutor or to Mrs Wilson in the student reception.



# Residential Trip to Hagg Farm

## Essential jobs before the trip

- Ensure OV4 is complete
- Payment is complete
- Kit is planned including hats and gloves.
- Sleeping bag is acquired
- Medical supplies and info discussed with trip leader for any significant medical conditions

## Essentials on day of leaving

- Meet staff in the dining room on the morning of the trip to register
- Label all medication, including instructions, and hand to staff in a bag that is clearly labelled with name and tutor group.
- Ensure all kit is packed and ready
- Remember a packed lunch for that day
- **Bring a smile and kiss your parents before leaving for school**
